

Sutton Win a Trio of Medals in Brighton

Sunday 15th November saw round 8 of the London Cyclocross League, which was also a round of the British Cycling SE Go Ride Interclub Competition.

The weather conditions meant that the going was officially “soft”, making for a tough race. However, this did not deter our Sutton riders who all rode well, achieving a great result for us.

In the U10 race Josh Mead won the bronze medal finishing 3rd.

Thomas Ives finished 4th and Dominic Cook 7th.

Lucas Mead was 11th and Lewis Glaysher 12th a good finish for our U8's.



In the U12 race Matthew McGovern finished 6th overall, but 3rd in the Interclub competition and winning the bronze medal.

Thomas Neville fought on through the mud to finish 13th and Toby Cook 14th.

The Youth Race had a big turnout of 25 riders with Chris McGovern the sole representative of Sutton CC in the U16 section.

Chris finished 7th overall, but 3rd overall again winning the bronze medal.



Later, in the Seniors race with a massive entry of 117 riders, former club member Matthew Zietz scored a spectacular 2nd. Wilf Sinclair riding for Sutton was 36th.
